Delaware Health Requirements for Poultry Shows

All exhibitors must show proof that poultry originated from a Pullorum-Typhoid-Free breeder birds and have tested negative for Pullorum-Typhoid and Avian Influenza.

Out of State birds

All birds shall be accompanied by a USDA VS Form 9-3 or similar paperwork indicating the owner's name and address, flock location, breed tested, and verification of the above negative test results and dates of tests. Or 9-3 and AI testing within 21 days of entry OR Health Certificate within 30 days of entry, and a PT within 90 days of entry and AI testing within 21 days of entry.

In State birds

9-3 papers or PT testing within 90 days of the show. No AI testing required

There may be additional Biosecurity protocols due to concerns for Avian Influenza.

All birds will be inspected for general health upon presentation. Any birds showing clinical signs of any contagious or infectious disease will be removed from the show. Any questions contact Oliver Menard, Delaware Agricultural Inspector

Judging will begin about 9:30 a.m. on Saturday April 11th.

Awards will be given at about 11 a.m. Sunday, April 12th or earlier if possible.

Sale cages are available on a first-come, first-served basis to exhibitors only (\$5.00 per cage).
There is a limit of (4) four birds per cage.

THE SALE OF UNTESTED BIRDS ON SHOW GROUNDS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN!

The Delaware State Fairgrounds strictly prohibit the sale of poultry in the parking area. No tailgate sales will be permitted.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries, exhibitors, and visitors are subject to these rules and regulations.
2. The show is open to all entries of standard and recognized non-standard varieties of Large Fowl, Bantams, and Waterfowl.
3. Entries must be postmarked by March 28th, 2026 and accompanied by an entry fee of \$5.00 per bird. Send a check made **payable to: Delmarva Poultry Fanciers** with an entry form to **Richard Barczebski, 6827, Smyrna, DE 19977.** Phone number: 302-382-0538 email: Richbar302@gmail.com
4. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
5. Birds must be in coops by 9:00 a.m. Saturday, April 11th, 2026. Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m.
6. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry.
7. Cooping arrangements will be made at the discretion of the Show Management.
8. Birds showing signs of sickness or injury upon arrival or during the show will be removed from the showroom.
9. Exhibitors may or may not be permitted in the aisle where the judging is being conducted at the discretion of the judge and the Show Committee.
10. Judging will follow the A.P.A. and A.B.A.'s Standard of Perfection.
11. No person except the exhibitor, the Judge, or the Show Management shall handle or feed any bird without expressed permission of the exhibitor.
12. The Delmarva Poultry Fanciers Club and the Show Committee will use every precaution to guard against accidents, mistakes, losses, or damage but will not be responsible should any occur.
13. Exhibitors shall be responsible for accepting their awards when presented.
14. All specimens shall be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
15. The Show Management urges that all birds be banded, although this is not required, and the band number be written on the coop tag as the birds go into the coop. Do not write the exhibitor's name on the card until judging is completed.
16. No bird shall be removed from the show hall without the expressed permission of the Show Chairman.
17. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted at this show.
18. Exhibitors making entries and failing to exhibit will automatically forfeit all fees paid for such entries unless the secretary is notified before the closing date of entries.
19. The Delmarva Poultry Fanciers Club will only be responsible for awards the club offers, not those provided by individuals.
20. In all matters dealing with the show's administration, the Show Committee's decision shall be final.
21. No substitutions will be permitted after the closing date of entries.
22. If competing for junior awards, it must be stated on the entry form in the upper right corner.
23. **Junior exhibitors must be present during the show, at coop-in and coop-out, and must handle their own birds, or awards will be forfeited.**
24. Delaware Health Requirements must be followed. The cover sheet of this premium list specifically lists all requirements. Birds not properly tested will be refused entry.
25. Runner ducks will be shown in the ring first thing Saturday morning. All runners must be Banded and runner exhibitors must be present to assist with their birds.
26. If you do email entries, they must be paid for before you put birds in their cage.

Judges decisions are final.

Birds deemed sick or infested must be removed from the show hall.

An entry fee of \$5.00 per bird must be sent with the entry form.

Payment for entries is made to Delmarva Pigeon Club.

Entries must be received by March 28th. Late entries cannot be accepted.
